All camps are held in the Centerville High School gymnasiums.

COED GENERAL SKILLS \$65

July 19-22, 12:00pm to 2:00pm

This camp is recommended for boys and girls in grades 4 through 7 who are at the beginning stages of competitive volleyball.

Campers will learn the basic skills of serving, passing, hitting, as well as team offense/defense mechanics appropriate for players in their first years of volleyball experience.

GIRLS' GENERAL SKILLS \$75

July 19-22, 8:00am to 11:00am

This camp is recommended for girls who have at least two years of interscholastic or competitive club volleyball experience. Campers will work in all volleyball skills at a fast, advanced pace, specialization drills at specific positions (setter, hitter, libero), and team offense/defense tactics.

BOYS' GENERAL SKILLS \$75

July 19-22, 2:30pm to 5:30pm

This camp is recommended for boys who have at least two years of interscholastic or competitive club volleyball experience. Campers will work in all volleyball skills with emphasis on increasing quickness, accuracy, and advanced offense/defense team strategies.

CAMPERS SHOULD....

Arrive 20 minutes early on first day of camp for check-in

Come dressed in appropriate clothing (shorts, comfortable t-shirt, and gym shoes). Kneepads are not required but are encouraged for the older age groups.

Bring your own water bottle or favorite sports drink. A small snack is optional.
